

Hot and Bothered this Summer?

Stay comfortable with Solar Roof Ventilation – and save money!

During the same time – the Solar Whiz has made quite a stir in the traditional “Whirlybird” market for roof ventilation – which has seen lively discussions on energy efficiency forums like the Alternative Technology Association about the pros and cons of conventional roof ventilation with “whirlybirds” vs the solar powered high airflow alternatives.

The success of the solar powered Solar Whiz roof ventilator is easy to understand. One Solar Whiz unit moves about 20 times

as much air as a whirlybird – and takes the same time to install.

Cooling your roof space and therefore controlling the amount of heat getting into your home is all about air-changes – the more air-changes per hour – the closer you can get to the outside ambient temperature.

The Solar Whiz not only reduces the temperature in the roof space and therefore your home. If you use ducted air-conditioning – it could make your system about 20% more efficient when running – and also reduce the need for running it. This is true for all homes – but in particular for multi-storey homes, which normally get very hot upstairs and therefore require air-conditioning through most of the summer.

Solar Whiz offers a wide range of roof ventilators to suit different sizes and

types of homes – and the website offers detailed information about how the product works, but the principle is simple. A solar powered fan extracts hot air from the roof space – and draws cooler replacement air into the roof space via ceiling and/or eave vents – cooling down the roof space thereby reducing the heat build-up both in the roof space and the house.

The Solar Whiz is a simple, but very effective product and therefore lends itself well to DIY, however Solar Whiz has a network of dealers covering most of Australia, who can advise on the best roof ventilation solution – and supply and install what you need to stay comfortable this summer.
